Albi is situated on the Tarn river only 85km northeast of Toulouse. The episcopal city was added to the UNESCO list of World Heritage Sites in 2010.

The city was built around the Sainte Cécile cathedral and episcopal group of buildings. This historic area covers 63 hectares and red brick and tiles are the main feature of most of the edifices. Along with Toulouse and Montauban, Albi is one of the main cities built in Languedoc-style red brick. Older than the Palais des Papes in Avignon, the Palais de la Berbie, formerly the Bishops' Palace of Albi, now the Toulouse-Lautrec Museum, is one of the oldest and best preserved castles in France.



This day trip includes a guided tour of the cathedral and free time to wander the streets and the different shops.
